

ON RECEPTION OF THE PRECIOUS BLOOD

I am glad that more parishioners are availing themselves of the opportunity to receive "the fullness of the sign" in receiving both the Body and the Blood of Christ at Mass. A reminder that no one should fear catching germs from sipping from the cup, since germs cannot live on the inert metal of the cup, and the cup is carefully wiped and turned each time a communicant sips from it. People may still think it is safer to dip the host into the chalice; unfortunately, this is not permitted according to the universal law of the Church. The Congregation for Divine Worship, in their document "Redemptionis Sacramentum," of 2004 clearly states: "the communicant must not be permitted to intinct the host himself" (#104) (i.e. no dipping of the host into the chalice). They do not specify the reasons, but for one thing, dipping could lead to drops of Precious Blood spilling on the floor. In any case, this instruction is universal Church law that we are obliged to follow. Fr. Tim
