Dear Parishioners,

With great joy I announce that God is offering a tremendous grace to our parish for our feast day of the Immaculate Conception of Mary on December 8th.

Our Archbishop writes, "In keeping with the theme of our 2007-2008 Pastoral Year, 'Together with Mary Let Us Live the Eucharist,' I hereby grant to the faithful of the Archdiocese and of your parish the possibility of gaining the plenary indulgence on the occasion of the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary.

He reminds us that we may gain the plenary indulgence under the usual conditions: participation at Mass on our feast day, reception of the Sacrament of Penance (Parish Reconciliation December 5th), and prayers for the intention of the Holy Father.

He has also asked that the faithful be "well-catechized on this devotional exercise" in order to avoid "false conceptions of the treasure of merits and indulgences that would harm the faith by introducing notes of superstition or credulity." To that end, I will be explaining further the meaning of a plenary indulgence.
