## Solemnity of St. Peter & Paul Together With Mary We Live the Eucharist

"Eucharistic Heart of Jesus, may your kingdom come through the Immaculate Heart of Mary." "Eucharistic Heart of Jesus, burning with love for us, set our hearts on fire with love for you."

My brothers and sisters in Christ,

As we wrap up this pastoral year dedicated to the Eucharist, and begin a year in commemoration of St. Paul (as the universal Church celebrates the 2<sup>nd</sup> millenia of his birth), let us keep in mind both Paul and the Eucharist. I invite everyone to re-discover Paul by re-reading his letters this coming year.

For the people of 4:30 Mass, since I will miss you (being away on our little parish pilgrimage to St. Joseph's), I share with you one point of my Sunday homily - Paul's teaching on the inseparability of mutual love and a worthy celebration of the Lord's Supper (1 Cor 11:17-34), on the link between love of God and love of neighbour, "sursum corda" (we lift up our hearts to the Lord) and "pax vobis" (peace be with you - the sign of peace given to our neighbour).

I firmly believe that the more we adore Christ in the Eucharist, the more our hearts will open to our brother or sister next to us in the pew. And the more we come to Mass with our walls and defenses down, with our hands extended in friendship, ready to meet Jesus in others, the more we will recognize him in the host and rejoice in his love.
