Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

With the secular celebration of **Hallowe'en** on this Sunday night, we Catholics remind ourselves of the religious significance of All Hallow's Day or **All Saints' Day** on which we remember all the saints in heaven, and the universal call to holiness - God calls all of us to be saints.

I share with you this quote from St. Faustina, about the shortest road to sanctity: "My Jesus, it is truly easy to become holy; it just takes a little good will! And if He finds this minimum of good will in a soul, He quickly gives Himself to her. And nothing can stop Him, neither our faults nor our falls, absolutely nothing. Jesus hurries to help that soul; and if the soul is faithful to this grace from God, she can in a short time reach the highest level of holiness that a created being can attain here below. God is very generous and does not refuse His grace to anyone. He gives even more than we ask for. The shortest road is faithfulness to the inspirations of the Holy Spirit" (*In The School of the Holy Spirit* by Jacques Philippe, p. 9).
