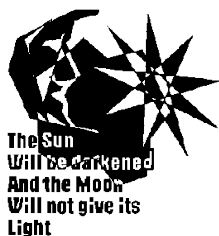

The main topic was the **NEW TRANSLATION OF THE MASS** in the English-speaking world, due out in Advent 2011 in the U.S., and hopefully very soon after in Canada. The updated translation is more faithful to the original Latin, and its language more dignified and beautiful, helping us to lift up our hearts and minds to God in worship. These changes offer all of us - priests and laity - the opportunity to re-discover the mystery of the Eucharist and the joy of worshiping God in union with the saints and angels in heaven, a foretaste of our eternal life.

In other news, Pope Benedict's new apostolic exhortation on the **WORD OF GOD, *Verbum Domini***, has recently been released in English (Our Holy Father encourages us to listen anew to God who speaks to us personally through His Word in the Scriptures. How blessed we are as Catholics, to enjoy our Lord so close to us in Word and Sacrament!
