

In today's gospel, Jesus uses the image of the vine and its branches to remind us that alone and unaided, we are as spiritually worthless as the cut-off branch of a vine, which is the most worthless of all wood! In his homily during his apostolic visit to Malta two years ago, Pope Benedict XVI said: "It is tempting to think that today's advanced technology can answer all our needs and save us from all the perils and dangers that beset us. But it is not so. At every moment of our lives we depend entirely on God, in whom we live and move and have our being. Only he can protect us from harm, only he can guide us through the storms of life, only he can bring us to a safe haven..."
