*Born on February 7, 1970 to Heribert Riesbeck, a
native of Germany and Colette Levesque, originally
from Grand Falls, New Brunswick.

*His elementary schooling took place in Aylmer,
Quebec and in Nepean, Ontario and his secondary
schooling at St. Pius X High School in Nepean.

*He earned a Bachelor of Social Sciences degree in
political science from the University of Ottawa, a
Master of Divinity degree from St. Augustine's
Seminary in Toronto and a Master's degree and
Licentiate in Canon Law from St. Paul's University,
Ottawa.

*Ordained to the priesthood by Archbishop Marcel
Gervias as a member of the Companions of the Cross
on October 12, 1996.

*Served for brief periods between 1996 and 1999 at
our Lady of Lourdes parish in Kingston, St. Jude's
parish in Hawkesbury, Our lady of Divine Love in
Pendleton and St. Francis Xavier in Brockville before
becoming pastor of Queen of Peace parish in Houston,
Texas (1999-2008).
