#### **The Light of Christ**

The Light of Christ has come into the world. We  
receive this Light so that we may enjoy His loving  
peace and harmony. “The reality is that in living in  
this world, the mansion that is our soul is full of  
rooms that contain darkness and dim light. When  
we act like Mary, we offer ourselves in obedience  
to God's will and in so doing, find that Christ's  
light scatters that darkness, providing us the  
warmth and clarity that we desire. Obedience is the  
un-bloody sacrifice that we are all called to, every  
day of our lives. It is through obedience to the will  
of God that we find that we grow in greater unity  
with God, bringing light and joy to our lives.”

“The more we live this purifying obedience to the  
will of God, and receive his refining and warming
