Today we hear once more the engaging story about two disciples who, apparently, had lost their perspective while on a journey. While in Jerusalem, they witnessed the horrific death of Jesus, Whom they had hoped would be the answer to their problems. They were devastated! However, during the breaking of bread in their hometown of Emmaus, they recognized Him and saw that He was alive! Alleluia!!

The Mass, our Emmaus

We gather to celebrate the Eucharist. We listen to the word of God. We break bread together. Jesus comes to us, not as a stranger, but as a brother and friend, to give us new hope to face the future with faith in Him. During mass, we are invited to tell our stories to the Lord. These stories may not make sense to us; we may be filled with disappointment. However, the Lord's presence gives us joy every day. Here at mass, we are invited to listen to Him as He speaks His Word and to recognize Him in the breaking of the bread.

Traditionally, the month of May is dedicated to Mary, the Mother of the Saviour and our Mother. Mary is presented to us as one Who responded generously to the love of the Father. Her entire life was that of humble submission to the Divine will. With Her 'Yes', She united Her will to God's will.
