World Mission Sunday

Today is World Mission Sunday, a special day in the liturgical year we are invited to think about our call to be missionaries and also to pray for the Church's missionary activities. The theme for this year's is: "...all are missionaries and disciples..." In the Spirit of the New Evangelization, "primarily a spiritual activity to recapture the courage and forcefulness of the first Christians and first missionaries", we are reminded of the urgency of our vocation and disciples and missionaries in our world today. As Christians we all share in the mission of the Church, it is in fact what defines our identity, it is our life. The Council Fathers clearly stated this fact thus:

"Their main duty, whether they are men or women, is the witness which they are bound to bear to Christ by their life and works in the home, in their social milieu, and in their own professional circle.
