Today the church invites us to celebrate Jesus as the King of the universe and most importantly, the King and Centre of our hearts. The challenge before us today is to be able to recognize Christ in the less fortunate among us. By recognizing Jesus in the poor and needy, we become part of His kingdom.

When we try to think of people who have responded to this invitation in a radical manner, we think of Blessed Mother Teresa who became famous by helping the poor and destitute people living in the slums of Calcutta. Mother Teresa's extraordinary acts of charity were motivated by her conviction that Christ lives in each and every human person especially the poor and the suffering.
