Pastor's Corner

On this second Sunday of Advent, we have John the Baptist, the prophet sent by God. John was the voice crying in the wilderness: "Prepare the Way for the Lord, make His path straight." John was blunt in delivering his message to the Israelites. The same message he has for us today. He challenges us to turn to the Lord, to repent. And the question is: Do we repent? Do we seek the way of the Lord?

Be Not Afraid

To repent and to seek the way of the Lord means to follow Him on His own terms and not on our own terms. Sometimes we find it hard to open up to God; to give Him the permission to take full possession of our life which is what conversion is all about. During this Advent, try to ask yourself: "What part of my life do I find difficult to surrender to Him? What is stopping me? Is it fear?"

Our God

Our God is a God of all consolation! Listen again to the opening words of today's first reading: "Comfort, O comfort my people...speak tenderly to Jerusalem, and cry to her that she has served her term, that her penalty is paid, that she has received from the Lord's hand double for all her sins." This is our God! The entire passage is filled with His warmth and love. He loves us through and through and has called us to follow Him in order to enjoy the fullness of life.
