The Call

In today's gospel, Jesus called the two fishermen-brothers and their colleagues, Peter and Andrew, James and John to follow Him; to be fishers of men! These men, we are told, left EVERYTHING and followed Jesus. The fundamental question is: what was it that attracted them to this man, Jesus? What was it that made them abandon their career, and in the case of James and John, even their father, to follow Him? We might not know what that could be. But one thing we know for sure is, in their minds, Jesus was worth following!

The Joy of Following Jesus

Following the Lord gives us great joy! Peter and his colleagues must have experienced this tremendous joy, as they abandoned their former means of livelihood in order to follow Jesus.
