The season of Lent begins on Ash Wednesday, February 18. Lent helps us to draw closer to God and rediscover who we are through acts of prayer, fasting and almsgiving. Please be reminded that Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of fast and abstinence. The Archbishop Prendergast has also decreed that clergy, religious and faithful observe abstinence not only on Good Friday, but on the other Fridays of lent as well for the spiritual good of the faithful of the diocese. Our Ash Wednesday liturgy in which ashes are distributed starts at 7 pm in the church. Please join us.
