Pastor's Corner

For the third week in a row the gospel teaches about forgiveness. Today we encounter Jesus, who is slow to condemn but quick to pardon, to forgive! The story of the woman caught in the very act of committing adultery once again highlights God's infinite goodness and mercy. During this Holy Year of Mercy, we are called to rediscover the merciful face of our God. Jesus is the face of God; He is the visible image of the invisible God.

"Go Your Way And Sin No More"

Today's gospel presents the magnificent story of the mercy and compassion of Jesus as He forgives the woman caught in the very act of adultery. With such great love Jesus sent the woman home to the consternation of her accusers who themselves had all sorts of skeletons in their cupboards. That is how easily God forgives! Yes, He is slow to condemn but quick to forgive as He said to the woman: "Neither do I condemn you, go and sin no more." The gospel challenges us to be quick to forgive as Jesus forgives.
