INTENTIONS OF THE HOLY FATHER FOR OCTOBER:

Evangelization – The Mission of Religious

That consecrated religious men and women may bestir themselves, and be present among the poor, the marginalized, and those who have no voice.

Gospel Reflection

The Gospel focuses on God's desire that humans have blessings and positive experiences from their human relationship in the way that God originally intended them to have. Human weakness has weakened the interpretation of what God desires for human relationships. Before sin entered the world, God had created man and woman to be images of God and to share in God's personal relationship and the divine process of creation. As I reflect on the readings and think about my journey of faith, I realize that one of the greatest of Gods gifts to each of us is the gift of relationship. Being able to relate to others is the essence of God.

Gods loving relationship is so powerful that it is creative – it has led to the creation of the universe. In His ministry (which continues today) Jesus restores health within bodies which are out of relationship within themselves. He forgives sins, that is He heals broken relationships between us and God. He also lifts people up to a higher level of relating to God and to each other.

God loves us in spite of our sinfulness. God wants us to be in the fullest relationships that are possible not only with God but also with others. The more we are in positive, growth-filled relationships with others, the more we reflect the relationship God has within the Trinity and the relationship God has designed for us.

God is the origin of all relationships. "Blessed are you who fear the Lord, who walk in God's ways! For you shall eat the fruit of your handiwork; blessed shall you be, and favored.

"The personal question/action for today: What does it mean to me that God desires that I be a person (more accurately, three Persons) of relationships? How is my relationship with God at this point in my faith journey? How does my relationship with God flow into my relationship with my family members, my friends, my acquaintances? How can I improve my various relationships – with God, within my family, with others? What can I do to promote healthy relationships in other people?
