**This fall, OLMM is offering Catechesis of the Good
Shepherd (CGS) Level 1** for children aged 3-5 years old
(born in 2014- 2016), **Level 2** for 6-8 years old (born in

2010). CGS is a Montessori approach to sharing the
Christian faith with children. Together with trained

auxiliary members and pray the rosary and legion prayers
daily. Active members attend a weekly meeting and do an
assigned volunteer work. All should be done in a spirit of
