The Ottawa Diocesan Season for the Care of Creation ministry has created 2 pages of suggestions for actions we can take as individuals & as individual households. This fall, OLMM is offering Catechesis of the Good Shepherd (CGS) Level 1 for children aged 3-5 years old (born in 2014- 2016), Level 2 for 6-8 years old (born in 2011-2013) and Level 3 for 9-11years old (born in 2008-2010). CGS is a Montessori approach to sharing the Christian faith with children. Together with trained catechists, children will listen to and wonder about scripture, and be engaged in elements of the Church in a space called the atrium. The cost is \$200.00 for one child, \$100 for each additional child in the family. Payment plan options available upon request. Please pick up registration forms in the foyer or at the parish office.
