Day 1, Sun, Sep 8 Ottawa-Dubrovnik Fly from Ottawa to Dubrovnik via Montreal and Vienna. Output
Day 2, Mon, Sep 9 Dubrovnik Arrive in Dubrovnik, Croatia, get settled, and relax in the hotel. Then, celebrate Mass, dinner, and a restful night.
Day 3, Tues, Sep 10 Dubrovnik Following breakfast, enjoy a walking tour of Old Town Dubrovnik. Then, enjoy lunch on your own. The rest of the day is at leisure to explore the city or the beach.
Day 4, Wed Sep 11Excursion to MontenegroFollowing breakfast, depart for Montenegro. Enjoy a boat ride to Our Lady of the Rocks. Then explore the charming town of Perast. Return to Dubrovnik for dinner and overnight.
