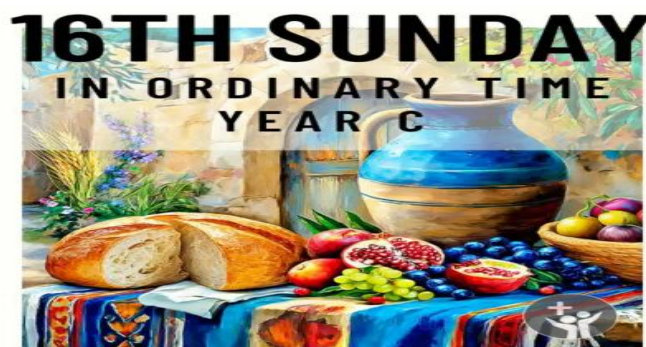

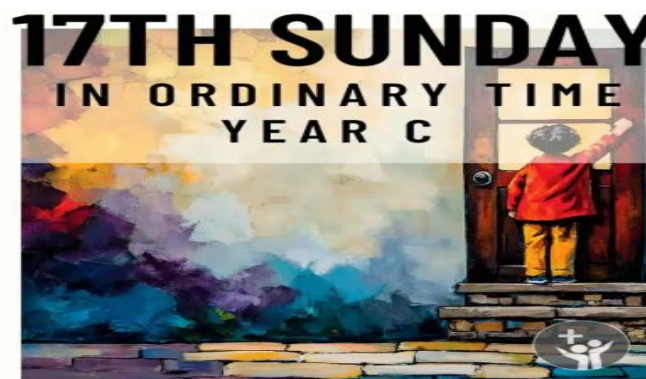
**HAPPY SUMMER!**

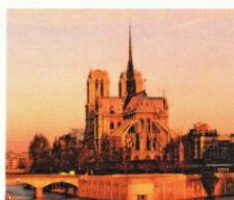
