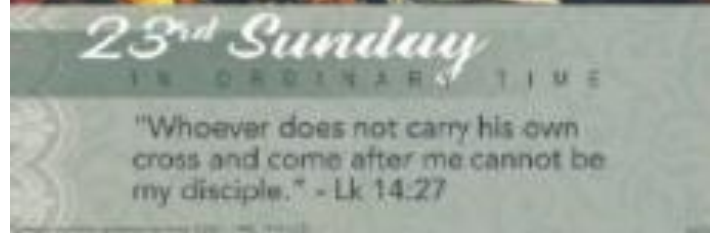

23RD SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Readings: Wis 9:13-18b/Phlm 9-10, 12-17/Lk 14:25-33

To be a disciple requires that we pick up our cross and follow Christ. Sometimes we do not know what that means, so we go looking for crosses that we think will be good enough. But the crosses come as part of our daily lives and we pick them up by the way we respond to the situations as Christ would have us respond. Look at Onesimus in the second reading today. A runaway slave whose name means “useful.” After his baptism, he is sent back to his owner. This could not have been easy. But neither would it be easy for his owner to now treat him as a brother in Christ. How do we respond to the situations in our own lives? Do we trust that, even in the most difficult situations, Jesus is there with us to show us the way?

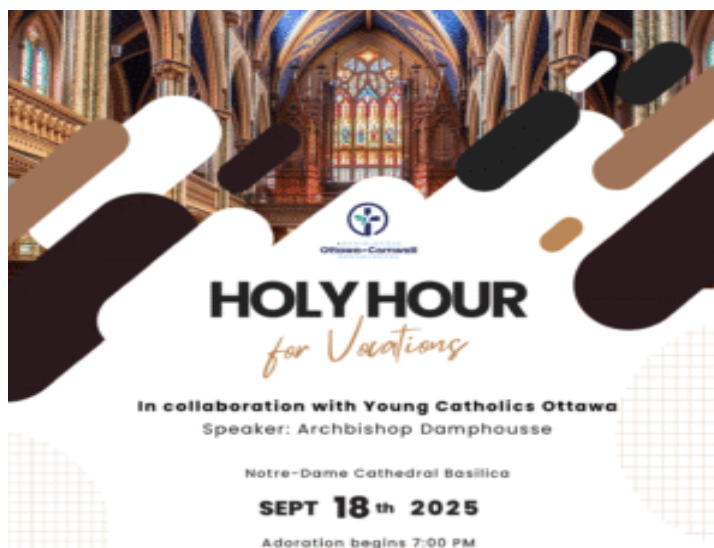
