after Stations of the Cross)



Readings: Gn 12:1-4a/2 Tm 1:8b-10/Mt 17:1-9

The Transfiguration shows Jesus Christ revealed in glory before Peter the Apostle, James the Apostle, and John the Apostle. Overwhelmed, Peter wants to build tents and remain in that holy moment. But the vision is not meant to be permanent—it is preparation. Jesus is on His way to the cross, and the apostles need strength for what lies ahead. The mountaintop glory is given to sustain them in the valley.

We, too, receive moments of light—in prayer, Scripture, or retreat. We cannot stay there. We must return to daily struggles and carry our crosses. But we do not go back unchanged. The light we receive strengthens us to remain faithful and trust that God walks with us through every trial.
