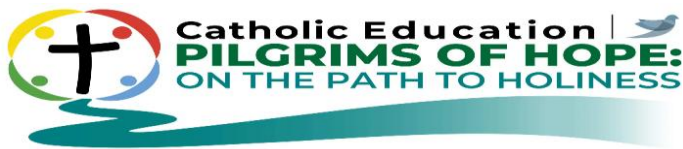

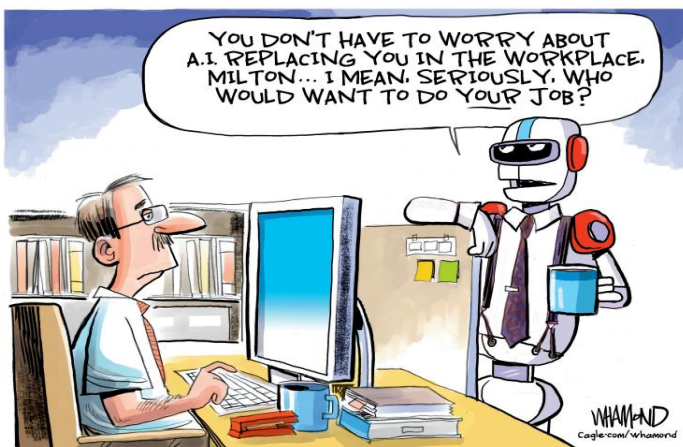
we pray together...
