This fall, Our Lady of the Miraculous Medal Parish is pleased to offer Our Lady's Children's Faith Formation (OLCFF).

Programs are available for Level 1 (ages 3–5), Level 2 (ages 6–8), and Level 3 (ages 9–11).

OLCFF is a Montessori-based approach to nurturing children's faith. Rooted in Sacred Scripture, the liturgy, and the rich traditions of the Catholic Church, it invites children into a deeper relationship with Jesus in a peaceful, prayerful environment. Guided by trained catechists, children listen to and reflect on Scripture, engage with hands-on materials that bring the faith to life, and discover the beauty of the Mass and the sacraments in a sacred space called the Atrium. Registration forms are available in the church foyer and at the parish office. Space is limited, so early registration is encouraged. Please return completed registration forms to the parish office.
