Instead of focusing on what others have, let us see our blessings as gifts and opportunities to give. A kind word, a helping hand, or an act of compassion can become a beautiful expression of God’s love. Let us give generously without seeking praise or recognition, and without keeping track of what we have given. What matters is not that others know what we have done, but that we give with a sincere and loving heart. True joy is not found in having more, but in becoming more grateful, generous, and willing to serve others.*

*Actions speak louder than words. Jesus tells of two sons: one initially refuses his father but later changes his mind and obeys, while the other says yes but does not follow through. True obedience is shown not simply by what we say, but by how we live. God looks at our hearts and choices. It is not enough to say we believe—we are called to live our faith. When we turn away from sin, admit our mistakes, and choose what is right, God welcomes us with mercy and love. Through repentance, we find renewed hope, peace, and joy in His presence.*
